

## The Night Before

between the Last Supper and the Garden of Gethsemane (Jn 14-17)

### John 13

33-37 Jesus: I'm going - learn to **Love** like Me (Commandment)

Peter: where? - I want to be with You

### John 14

2-3 make a "dwelling place" for you in My Father's "household" (root Eph 2:19) - **Cross!**

(Ep 1:6) He made us accepted in the Beloved. (not just house in heaven - family)

(Rev 21:7) He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. (1Jn 5:4-5)

I'll be back so you can be with Me

6 I'm the only one that can get you into the Family

10-11 Jesus and Father are One (Shema Deut 6:4-5)

16-18 I'll also be with you through the Holy Spirit in you (orphans?)

(Ro 8:14-17) <sup>14</sup>For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. <sup>15</sup>For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." <sup>16</sup>The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, <sup>17</sup>and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

20 once in the Family you'll be One with Us

23 and We can make you Our dwelling place

### John 15

4-5 stay in our shared dwelling place - act from there (family relationship)

9 stay confident in My love for you

12, 17 so you can keep My command to Love one another

19-20 in a world that hates and persecutes you

(1Pe 4:12-13) <sup>12</sup>Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; <sup>13</sup>but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.

26-27 this is our witness of Jesus

John 16 7 making a way to be in the Family is better vs Him ruling now (alone)

John 17 21-24 One, with Jesus

Response: Righteousness (Jn 16:1), Joy (Jn 15:11), Peace (Jn 14:27, Jn 16:33) (Rom 8:36-37)

Jesus went to the Cross to give us His Kingdom!

(Ro 14:17) for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

this is our witness in the earth until He comes
