Resurrection Life

(1Co 15:1-4) Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

Gospel = Crucifixion & Resurrection (for our sins – Passover)

We Die with Him

(Ga 2:20) ²⁰I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

We Live with Him

(2Ti 2:11) "This is a faithful saying: for if we died with Him, we shall also live with Him. Can't have Resurrection Life without Dieing (Mt 16:24-26)

Resurrection Live through Death

(Ro 6:3-10) ³Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? ⁴Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. ³For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, ³knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. ³For he who has died has been freed from sin. ³Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, ³knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. ¹⁰For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.

What does Resurrection Life look like?

not just heaven, we can have abundant life now (Jn 10:10)

(Ro 6:11-13) "Likewise you also, <u>reckon yourselves</u> to be <u>dead indeed to sin</u>, but <u>alive to God</u> in Christ Jesus our Lord. "Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. "And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

We can Choose what to be Alive or Dead to.

ex: peace vs. worry & fear, faith vs. doubt

(Col 3:1-5) If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things

on the earth. ³For <u>you died</u>, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. ⁵Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

Develop Resurrection Mindset (Heaven to Earth)
You Died: past tense, once – now Reckon (vs 5)
dead acting alive = Zombie (kill it)
some zombies hard to kill – Jesus help, spiritual weapons

(2Co 5:14-21) ¹⁴For the <u>love of Christ compels us</u>, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; ¹⁵and He died for all, that those who live should <u>live no longer for themselves</u>, but for Him who died for them and rose again. ¹⁶Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. ¹⁷Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. ¹⁸Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the <u>ministry of reconciliation</u>, ¹⁹that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, <u>not imputing their trespasses</u> to them, and has committed to us the <u>word of reconciliation</u>. ²⁰Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. ²¹For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Love Compels us to – Live for Him, Regard Others by Spirit Everyone – New Creation or need Word of Reconciliation Word of Reconciliation = Sins Forgiven, Righteousness Given
