

## Behold the Lamb

Gen 15 – God’s covenant with Abram by sacrifice (blood)

promise: an heir, innumerable descendants, land (inheritance)  
through faith – relationship (vs 1), righteousness (vs 6)

Gen 17 – name change to Abraham: father of nations

covenant extended to descendants by circumcision (blood, inheritance)

Gen 22 – Isaac (promised inheritance) sacrificed (faith – promise in God’s hands)

“God will provide the lamb” (vs 8)

mountain – temple, crucifixion, resurrection

Ex 12 – Passover

slaves, death of firstborn (inheritance)

annual feast, begin new year, remove leaven from house (sin)

lamb without blemish, stay inside, eat flesh, no broken bones (Jn 19:36)

only covenant people could eat

blood around door, death passes over

Ex 13

firstborn consecrated to God (Isaac – inheritance)

promised land: provision, blessing, health (Ex 15:26, Deut 7:13-15)

Ex 14 – Red Sea

presence (pillar of fire/cloud)

deliverance from enemies

Jer 31:31-34 New Covenant

law in minds/hearts, know Me, forgiven sin (not remembered)

Jesus mediates better covenant, better promises (Heb 8:6)

Rom 6 – from slaves of sin & death to slaves of righteousness (consecrated)

made completely new creations (2 Cor 5:17)

Crucifixion – sin *removed* by the Lamb (Jn 1:29, Heb 9:28, 2 Cor 5:21)

redeemed by the blood of the Spotless Lamb (1 Pe 1:18-19)

Passover inspection: Elders/Priests, Pharisees, Sadducees, Scribes

He cleansed His house of leaven (temple)

made us His temple, dwelling place (1 Cor 3:16)

as they were baptized/delivered in the Red Sea (1 Cor 10:1-4)

we are baptized into spiritual freedom/newness of life (Rom 6:4)

Resurrection – He is the Firstborn (heir) of all creation (Col 1:15)

we inherit eternal life through Him (Mt 19:29)

Covenant Promises (still provision, blessing, health)

His Kingdom (Lk 12:32) ~ all He has (Rom 8:17, Rev 21:7)

His Spirit: Presence (Jn 16:7, Acts 1:4-5)

fulfillment of Genesis 15 covenant

relationship and righteousness through faith

we consecrate ourselves to Him, He does the rest

Last Supper: remember (Mt 26:26-28)

stay in Jesus (Jn 15:4-5)

don't go out where the death angel can kill your inheritance

feed on Him (Jn 6)

consecrate ourselves (set apart for Him)

(1Co 5:7) Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.
