#### **Christmas Reminder**

Remind us as enter-Christmas season-Christmas >not about what we have to do-

>about what God has already done for us.

Christmas about- God initiating a plan- w/birth and blood of Christ- buy back/redeem- what Adam gave away in the garden of Eden.

From- baby in- manger to- man on the cross, we are called into a relationship w/Living Christ.

Of all people we should abound in hope because of what God has done for us through Christ.

Romans 15:13 Now may the <u>God of hope</u> fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will <u>abound in hope</u> by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Of all seasons, Christmas ought to be a season filled w/hope, as-remember birth of Christ.

To not live with <u>hope</u> is to deny the goodness of God and the very reason Jesus came as a baby in a manger.

#### Introduction

Title- Always Winter But Never Christmas.

Most- recognized- video clip from-movie/book-The Lion, the witch, and the wardrobe (Lewis).

The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe- story about 4 children- stumble into- land of Narnia.

Narnia- under the curse- White Witch- 100yrs-Father Christmas unable to enter Narnia.

As a result it was always winter- never Christmas.

Earlier this year P Tony reviewed our prophetic history- our is sense that- best is yet to come.

There is a great move of God coming.

This is something we-believed for a long time.

In waiting for the best to come- sometimes it feels like it is always winter but never Christmas.

When will Christmas come, when will- best come, when will we see a move of God?

How do we live in the meantime as we wait for that which we have hoped for, for so long?

Several parallels I want to pull out of this story.

## 1st- Perpetual Winter

Narnia's perpetual winter- picture of our world under Satan's rule/prince of the power of air.

As a result many struggle w/disappointment discouragement whether it be ...

>physical illnesses/financial problems

>relationship issues/broken families

>larger anxieties over what is happening in our nation and in the world today

How do we find <u>hope</u> when it seems like it is always winter and never Christmas?

Peter warns us ...

1 Peter 5:8 Be of <u>sober spirit</u>, be <u>on the alert</u>. Your <u>adversary</u>, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, <u>seeking</u> someone <u>to devour</u>.

The enemy wants to rob us of all hope and joy.
When- enemy gets our focus off Christ and on our disappointments it is easy to believe the lies that he is whispering in our ear.

Looking for someone- come into agreement with what he is saying so he can devour us.

St. Augustine said something challenging ...

For a believer discouragement/despair can become sin because it negates the hope we have in Christ. St. Augustine

We must fight-hold onto-hope in Christ-now/future Rom 8:25 But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

1 Pet 1:3 ... born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

Consider this verse-

Romans 8:19 For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God.

What this says to me is that we have a role to play as we wait for the best that is yet to come, the next move of God, the return of Christ

God has called us, commissioned us, and empowered us, to bring heaven to earth.

We have- role to play in- unfolding- human history **2nd- Rumors of the Kings return** 

In Narnia there were rumors- true King of Narnia was on the move/about to return.

As desperate as- people in Narnia were- allowed themselves to be encouraged by these rumors Today, when we hear- words/visions/dreams that people have that ...

>A great move of God- just around- corner >the Lord's return is near

... but- do we allow our hearts to be stirred and encouraged?

... or do we push them aside because weheard it all before, nothing changes?

We must guard against- voices of doubt/despair drowning out- promises we see in God's Word.

2 Cor 1.20-21 (TPT) For all of God's promises find their "yes" of fulfillment in him. And as his "yes" and our "amen" ascend to God, we bring him glory! Now, it is God himself who has anointed us. And he is constantly strengthening both you and us in union with Christ.

## 3rd- The Equipping of the Saints

As- time of- Kings return drew near- curse began to weaken and Father Christmas could return.

When he returned- encouraged- children- howequipped them for the struggle that laid ahead.

They were going to have to fight to see-promises.

2 Pet 1.3-4 (TPT) Everything we could ever need for life and complete devotion to God has already been deposited in us by his divine power. For all this was lavished upon us through the rich experience of knowing him who has called us by name and invited us to come to him through a glorious manifestation of his goodness.

In Christ we have everything we need to face our struggles-be successful in this life/one to come

4 As a result of this, he has given you magnificent promises that are beyond all price, so that through the power of these tremendous promises you can experience partnership with the divine

# nature, by which you have escaped the corrupt desires that are of the world.

Do not allow the enemy to convince you that you have no part to play and nothing to offer.

When you are in- middle of a trial or what seems to be the darkest hour- it is not time to quit.

It is time to call on the promises of God and reaffirm your commitment to Him.

## 4th- The temptation to compromise

Edmund allowed himself to be lured away by the White Witch with hope of immediate comfort.

She deceived him with the hope of fulfilling his immediate desires.

Today, the world/Satan- pulls at our affectionsparticularly in- middle of our disappointments.

Edmund chose to align himself w/White Witch.

We make choices everyday that either align us with God or with Satan.

Will we go deeper in faith and hold onto His promises, or believe- the lies of the enemy.

Understand this- when we agree w/one thing we are always challenging something else.

If we agree with the voice of Satan we are challenging the voice of God.

### How do we live in this season?

Lord dropped this in my heart ...

The time of God being on the move is just as important as the actual time of His arrival.

In this season of waiting on the Lord we must hold onto our hope- not passively- actively.

Mt 11:12 "From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven

# suffers violence, and violent men take it by force.

Yes, we all want to see miracles, we want to see broken bodies healed, justice for the righteous.

But how do we live in a time of ...

>rumors/small indications- God is on the move

>a healing here, a word there

>one prayed for is healed/another dies

>some people see triumphs/others tragedies

Regardless of the brokenness we see around us we must take hold of the reality-God is coming.

He is at work in ways we do not know, and He is preparing us for the days ahead.

Across the board, in all of life, we feel the tension of the "now-but-not-yet" of history and hope (Dr Steven Garber).

However sometimes it can feel like there is a lot more "not yet" than "now".

As believers we have the hope of the ...

>baby in a manager,

>man on the cross, and

>resurrected Christ seated-heavenly places
Jesus took on human flesh to give us an eternal
outlook and an eternal hope.

Micah 5:2 "But as for you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Too little to be among the clans of Judah, From you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, From the days of eternity."

Jesus is coming as King and Ruler.

But we must understand that the KofG has a ... >past reality,

- >future reality, and a
- >"here and now" reality.

God allows us glimpses of eternity in- here and now, as we wait for our eternal redemption.

Rev 1:8 "I am ... (He) ... "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

We must guard our hearts against both discouragement and compromised living.

As the people of God we are called to live with a heavenly perspective.

God calls us to be faithful in the natural so we can impact the eternal. Unknown

We have the privilege of working with God to bring His Kingdom to earth as it is in heaven.

Do not allow yourself to be shaped by what does not happen. Rather be motivated by what God has done. Bill J
