Ch 5: Walking Out our Position in Christ – Behavioral

Don't let Focus on Behavior Damage Relationships.

verses 1-7

Imitate God as His Children He Loves (Family) (Eph 3:17-19)

Love: Christ's Example (Jn 13:34), Sacrificial (Phil 2:3-7)

Immoral Behavior contrasted with Thankfulness

Principle: we Become what we Behold (2 Cor 3:18)

Focus: sin vs who we are in Him (Rom 6:11-12)

Thankfulness redirects our Focus

whose Family we are in determines our Inheritance

Only Two: Every Spiritual Blessing (Eph 1:3) vs Wrath (Jn 3:36)

(Rev 21:7-8) ⁷"He who overcomes shall <u>inherit all things</u>, and I will be his God and he shall be My <u>son</u>. ⁸"But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers,

sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the <u>lake</u> which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

(Mt 25:41) 41"Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels:

"sons of disobedience" Chose their Father (Jn 8:44)

by Choosing Immoral Behavior (Jn 3:19, Heb 10:26-31)

Choose Surpassing Pleasures in Him

verses 8-14

Darkness vs Light (Children) – Walk like you've been Enlightened (fruit/behavior)

Find Out (Learn) what He Accepts – Awake, Arise, enter into Light (Process)

No Fellowship with Darkness - Corrupting

(1Co 15:33-34) 33Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits."

<u>34Awake</u> to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the <u>knowledge</u> of God.

sinners: relationship, not participation (vs 7 - partake) (Mt 9:11-13)

Light Exposes Darkness (not Pointing)

our Example is Light: Fruit, Behavior (Surpassing Pleasures)

verses 15-20

Wisdom (Mt 10:16)

We Redeem Time by spending it on things with Eternal Value

We can be Wise and Understand His Will

be Filled with His Spirit (Surpassing Pleasure than wine - SoS 1:2)

Jesus Delighted in the Fear of God (Isa 11:3)

Jesus Delighted to do His Will (Psa 40:7)
