

Foundational Fear

Jesus' Delight in the Fear of the Lord (Isa 11:3) was expressed in only doing what He saw the Father do (Jn 5:19-20) - **Delightful Fear of the Lord: Desiring Only His Ways**

(Isa 11:1-2) ¹There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots. ²The Spirit of the **LORD** shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of **wisdom** and **understanding**, the Spirit of **counsel** and **might**, the Spirit of **knowledge** and of the **fear of the LORD**.

Seven Spirits of God

(Rev 4:5) ⁵And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

(Rev 5:6) ⁶And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

embodied in Jesus (Rev 3:1, Isa 11:2)

(Isa 11:3-4) ³His delight is in the fear of the LORD, and He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, nor decide by the hearing of His ears; ⁴but with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

Fear of the Lord - Foundation for Activity of His Spirit?

(Pr 1:7) ⁷The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

(Pr 2:5-6) ⁵Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God.

⁶For the LORD gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding;

(Pr 9:10) ¹⁰“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.”

(Job 28:28) ²⁸And to man He said, ‘Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to depart from evil is understanding.’

Chris Reed: Return of the Fear of the Lord is Key to the Return of the Supernatural. (Prayer)

(Ac 5:11-16) ¹¹So great fear came upon all the church and upon all who heard these things.

¹²And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with one accord in Solomon's Porch. ¹³Yet none of the rest dared join them, but the people esteemed them highly. ¹⁴And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. ¹⁶Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

Beneficial Fear

(Ps 25:12-14) ¹²Who is the man that fears the LORD? Him shall He teach in the way He chooses. ¹³He himself shall dwell in prosperity, and his descendants shall inherit the earth. ¹⁴The secret of the LORD is with those who fear Him, and He will show them His covenant.

(Ps 33:18-19) ¹⁸Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, on those who hope in His mercy, ¹⁹to deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

(Ps 34:7-10) ⁷The angel of the LORD encamps all around those who fear Him, and delivers them.

⁸Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who trusts in Him! ⁹Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him. ¹⁰The young lions lack and suffer hunger; but those who seek the LORD shall not lack any good thing.

(Ps 115:13) ¹³He will bless those who fear the LORD, both small and great.

(Ps 147:11) ¹¹The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His mercy.

(Pr 10:27) ²⁷The fear of the LORD prolongs life, but the years of the wicked will be shortened.

(Pr 14:26-27) ²⁶In the fear of the LORD there is strong confidence, and His children will have a place of refuge. ²⁷The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to turn one away from the snares of death.

(Pr 16:6) ⁶In mercy and truth atonement is provided for iniquity; and by the fear of the LORD one departs from evil.

(Pr 19:23) ²³The fear of the LORD leads to life, and he who has it will abide in satisfaction; he will not be visited with evil.

(Pr 22:4) ⁴By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches and honor and life.

(Pr 31:30) ³⁰Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, but a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

(Mal 3:16) ¹⁶Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, and the LORD listened and heard them; so a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the LORD and who meditate on His name.
