

## John 5

- 1-15 Jesus in Jerusalem for feast, heals on the Sabbath
- 16 Jews want to kill Him for doing Works on the Sabbath
- 17 Jesus is working because His Father is working  
our attitude? Do we look for the Father working?
- 18 Jews want to kill Him more for calling God Father (personal, unprecedented), equal
- 19-20 Jesus explains their **Familial Relationship** (Jesus' perspective)  
He can do Nothing but what He Sees the Father do  
He does Whatever the Father does (fully involved)  
because the Father Loves the Son (Father's perspective)  
He shows Jesus Everything He does (fully invested)  
He will show Jesus Greater Works so we can Marvel (focused on us)
- What happens when we become Loved Sons? (Jn 1)  
(Jn 14:12) Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.  
Why is Marveling important? Are we Looking for Marvelous Works?
- 21-23 Jesus reveals the **Equality** of their relationship and His **Purpose** regarding men like the Father, Jesus gives Life to whoever He wants (source - vs 26)  
Father has committed all Justice to Jesus  
their Honor is co-mingled
- 24-30 Jesus reveals the **Life & Death** nature of Justice, and the **Only Solution**  
Solution (vs 24): Listen to Jesus, Believe the Father Sent Him  
skip judgment, avoid death, everlasting life  
they are Equally the Source of Life (vs 26, Jn 1)  
Spiritually dead who hear Jesus' voice live (vs 25)  
(dead at time of Jesus - Eph 4:9, 1 Pe 3:19, 4:6)  
Resurrection of all dead to Final Life & Death Judgement (vs 28-29)  
His authority to Judge is as the Son of Man (vs 27, Rev 5)  
Impartial/Righteous because He only seeks the Father's will (vs 30)
- 31-47 Witnesses: John Baptist, Works (Sabbath), Father (Mt 3:17), Word, Moses (Deut 18:15)  
Three Reasons the Jews can't Hear Him
- 38-40 Rules over Relationship - haven't let His Word penetrate their Hearts
- 42 missed Love (Mt 22:37-40, Hos 6:6, Mt 9:13, 12:7)
- 44 seek Honor from men
