Service is Purpose of Authority (foot washing)

New Commandment: Love like Jesus

because He's going to Send them in His Authority when He goes (significance Jn 14-17)

(Jn 13:36) Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, where are You going?"

- 2nd massive paradigm shift - temple (limited access) to physical interaction (1 Jn 1:1)
- losing physical presence to ??? (Jn 16:7)

1 Worry vs Faith (context: losing comfort of proximity) - Person, not Outcome

2 Father's house: New Jerusalem (Rev 21), Him, Us

oikia - dwelling, Household (Family)

Us as God's household (oikeios Eph 2:19), house (oikos Heb 3:6)

mone - place to Abide (same word as Father, Son, and Us in vs 23)

In My Father's family are many places to abide.

I go (to the Cross) to make a Place for you (in the Father) (Eph 1:6)

significance of torn veil, temples of His Presence (1 Cor 3:16)

new paradigm of indwelling Spirit He's been speaking of...

Jesus giver of Spirit (Jn 1:33), must be born of Spirit (Jn 3:5),

worship in Spirit (Jn 4:24), Spirit gives life (Jn 6:63),

(Jn 7:37-39) ³⁷On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸"He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." ³⁹But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

3 2nd Coming, restoration of physical presence (upgraded)

(1Th 4:16-17) ¹⁶For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

(Rev 19:7) "Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."

time between is for our Preparation to be fully His (upgrade)

4-6 you know where I'm going and how to get there - nope, we really don't

Jesus is the Way, the Father (not a place) is Where (Jn 14:12, 28, 16:5, 10, 16, 28)

New Jerusalem - physical presence of Father on Earth (garden)

(Rev 21:2-3) ²Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.

(Rev 21:9-10) ⁹Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, “Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife.” ¹⁰And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

City and Bride are indistinguishable as His dwelling place

(Ep 2:20-22) ²⁰having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, ²¹in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, ²²in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Is His/our shared Spiritual Dwelling Place more Substantial than we know? (metaphor?)

Is recognizing our Oneness in Him with each other more important than we know?

1 Cor 3:16 (individual) vs Jn 17:20-23

7-11 they didn't grasp the Oneness of the Father and Son - Indwell Each Other dwells (vs 10) meno - to abide (root of mone vs 2)

Works are evidence of the Indwelling Father

Is grasping our shared Dwelling Place a Key to His Works? (Col 2:9-10)

12-14 We must let this Promise provoke us toward Fullness.
