(Heb 11:39-40) ³⁹And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the <u>promise</u>, ⁴⁰God having provided <u>something better</u> for us, that they should not be <u>made perfect</u> apart from us.

Living Spirit (Jn 3:3-8), War with Flesh (Gal 5:17), Incorruptible Body Labor with Eternal Mindset of Assured Victory (1 Cor 15:54, 58)

Mindset: <u>His Coming</u> vs Our Going (Rapture)

(1Th 4:13-18) ¹³But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. ¹⁴For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so <u>God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus</u>. ¹⁵For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the <u>coming of the Lord</u> will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶For the <u>Lord Himself will descend from heaven</u> with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to <u>meet the Lord in the air</u>. And thus <u>we shall always be</u> with the Lord. ¹⁸Therefore comfort one another with these words.

- 1. Biblical Focus is on His Coming (Rev 22:7, 12, 17, 20)
- 2. we aren't Going we Meet Him and Stay with Him

(2Th 2:1) ¹Now, brethren, concerning the <u>coming of our Lord</u> Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him,

He's bringing all the other Saints (1 Th 3:13, Jude 1:14)

He will Rule the Earth (Rev 19:11-16), and us with Him (Rev 5:10)

we Partner with Him to Redeem the Planet

(Ro 8:18-23) ¹⁸For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. ¹⁹For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. ²⁰For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; ²¹because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. ²²For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. ²³Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, <u>eagerly waiting</u> for the adoption, the redemption of our body.

3. Focus on His Coming & our Transformation is Comforting & Motivating (1Jn 2:28) ²⁸And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

(1Jn 3:2-3) ²Beloved, <u>now we are children of God</u>; and it <u>has not yet been revealed what we shall be</u>, but we know that <u>when He is revealed, we shall be like Him</u>, for we shall see Him as He is. ³And <u>everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself</u>, just as He is pure.

(1Th 2:19-20) ¹⁹For what is our <u>hope</u>, or <u>joy</u>, or <u>crown of rejoicing</u>? Is it not even <u>you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming</u>? ²⁰For you are our glory and joy.

(2Ti 4:7-8) ⁷I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸Finally, there is laid up for me the <u>crown of righteousness</u>, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me <u>on that Day</u>, and not to me only but also to <u>all who have loved His appearing</u>.

(Tit 2:11-13) ¹¹For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹²teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
