hints and foreshadows of Bridal Relationship in the Old Testament

(Isa 62:5) And as the bridegroom rejoices over the <u>bride</u>, so shall your God rejoice over you. context: Jerusalem - watchmen (Isa 62:6-7, Mt 23:37)

(Je 2:2) "Go and cry in the hearing of <u>Jerusalem</u>, saying, 'Thus says the LORD: "I remember you, the kindness of your youth, the <u>love of your betrothal</u>, when you went after Me in the <u>wilderness</u>, in a land not sown."

(Ho 2:14, 16, 19-20) ¹⁴"Therefore, behold, I will <u>allure</u> her, will bring her into the <u>wilderness</u>, and speak comfort to her. ⁶"And it shall be, in that day," says the LORD, "That you will call Me '<u>My Husband</u>,' and no longer call Me 'My Master,' ¹⁹"I will <u>betroth</u> you to Me forever; yes, I will <u>betroth</u> you to Me in righteousness and justice, in lovingkindness and mercy; ²⁰I will <u>betroth</u> you to Me in faithfulness, and you shall know the LORD.

context: Harlotry of Idolatry (New Covenant - Hos 1:6 - 2:1, 23 & 1 Pe 2:9-10) Song of Solomon - Metaphor

Mystery in the New Testament - Literal, not just Israel

(Ep 5:32) This is a great <u>mystery</u>, but I speak concerning <u>Christ and the church</u>. (Ep 5:25-27) ²⁵Husbands, love your wives, just as <u>Christ</u> also <u>loved the church</u> and <u>gave Himself</u> for her, ²⁶that He might <u>sanctify and cleanse her</u> with the washing of water <u>by the word</u>, ²⁷that He might <u>present her to Himself</u> a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be <u>holy and without blemish</u>.

Intense, Jealous Love & Radical Commitment (no concubines - partnership)

(Ex 34:14) for you shall worship <u>no other god</u>, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a <u>jealous God</u>

(Jas 4:4-5) ⁴<u>Adulterers</u> and <u>adulteresses</u>! Do you not know that <u>friendship with the world</u> is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. ⁵Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The <u>Spirit who dwells in us</u> <u>yearns jealously</u>"?

(Ep 5:30-32) ³⁰For we are <u>members of His body</u>, of His flesh and of His bones. ³¹"For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the <u>two shall become one</u> flesh." ³²This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

Radical Unity (Jn 17:21, Eph 1:6)

His Bride is a City (Rev 21:2, 9) - He has <u>One</u> Bride (Eph 2:22, 1 Pe 2:5)

(Rev 19:7-9) ⁷"Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the <u>marriage of the Lamb</u> has come, and <u>His wife</u> has <u>made herself ready</u>." ⁸And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. ⁹Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the <u>marriage supper of the Lamb</u>!""

Partnership of Eph 5:26-27 & Rev 19:7 is found in Eph 4:11-16

as His Bride we Receive Intimacy

as His Ministers we must want Him to Receive His Bride

(2 Co 11:2) For I am jealous for you with <u>godly jealousy</u>. For I have <u>betrothed you</u> to one husband, that I may <u>present you as a chaste virgin to Christ</u>.

(Jn 3:29-30) ²⁹"He who <u>has the bride</u> is the bridegroom; but the <u>friend of the bridegroom</u>, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled. ³⁰"<u>He must increase</u>, but I must decrease.

Friends of the Bridegroom are Committed to Preparing the Bride <u>for Him</u> they don't use, compete with, or disparage His Bride

Bride: Committed to Jesus Friend of Bridegroom: Committed to His Church His Bride being Ready is a Prerequisite to His Return (Jerusalem Mt 23:39)
