Review: ALL believers have a Holy Calling

Spirit of **Power**, Love, Sound Mind (need all 3 working together) – 1 Cor 12, 13, 14

1 Corinthians 12 – Gifts of Power (Rom 12, Eph 4)

(1Cor 12:7) But the <u>manifestation</u> of the Spirit is given to <u>each one</u> for the <u>profit of all</u>: All believers Manifest His Spirit

(Eph 4:7) But to <u>each one</u> of us <u>grace</u> was given according to the <u>measure of Christ's gift</u>. Purpose of His Gifts is to <u>build up</u> His Body (1 Cor 12:12-27)

(Eph 4:16) from whom the <u>whole body</u>, joined and <u>knit together by what every joint</u> <u>supplies</u>, according to the effective working by which <u>every part does its share</u>, causes <u>growth of the body</u> for the <u>edifying of itself</u> in love.

(<mark>1Cor 12:11</mark>) But one and the same <u>Spirit</u> works all these things, <u>distributing to each one</u> individually <u>as He wills</u>.

His Spirit decides Gifting (complement <u>Calling</u> Eph 2:10)

Diverse Gifts, Ministries, Activities (1 Cor 12:4-6), Functions (Rom 12:4)

lists aren't exhaustive (1 Cor 12:8-10, 28-30, Rom 12:6-8, Eph 4:11)

OT - singers & musicians (Levites), "gifted artisans" (Ex 28:3, 31:6, 35:10, 36:1) Diversity within individual gift

(Ro 12:3-5) ³For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, <u>not to</u> <u>think of himself more highly than he ought to think</u>, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. ⁴For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same <u>function</u>, ⁵so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually <u>members of one another</u>.

Don't Exalt your Gift (1 Cor 4:7) - for Service, not our Identity, not competition (2 Cor 10:12) (1Co 12:31) But <u>earnestly desire</u> the <u>best gifts</u>.

Do Strongly Desire His Gifts (1 Cor 14:1) - to build up church Ignorance (1 Cor 12:1), Neglect (1 Tim 4:14), Passivity (2 Tim 1:6) Gifts must be "stirred up" (practiced) because they don't come fully mature

We must <u>Believe</u> we are **Powerful** (1 Cor 4:20, 2 Tim 3:5) - especially Corporately

Allure of Victim Identity (world) - Excuse to not have to Overcome

Sheep for Slaughter (Rom 8:36), More than Conquerors (Rom 8:37)

Paul accepted being Victimized, but not a Victim Identity

Power to Overcome tied to Confidence in His Love (Rom 8:38-39)

Overcoming (Fruit) demonstrates His Power/Kingdom

(Eph 3:20) Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,
