## **5 People Guidelines**

- 8 Values: Humility, Mourning sin (others), Gentleness, Righteousness (hunger/thirst), Mercy, Heart Purity, Peacemaking, Fear of God (persecution)
- 5 Internal Enemies of the 8 Values: Anger, Lusts, Religious Performance, Demand for Justice, Right to Withhold Love
- 5 Practices that Cultivate the 8 Values: Service, Prayer, Forgiveness, Self Denial, Generosity
- 1 Demonic Attack: Anxiety/Worry/Fear
- **5 People Guidelines** because People are usually the Problem
- 1. Don't Judge People (Mt 7:1-6)
- (1Co 2:15) But he who is spiritual <u>judges all things</u>, yet he himself is rightly <u>judged by no one</u>. condemnation (krino) vs examination (anakrino)

(Ro 14:4) Who are you to judge another's servant? To his own master he stands or falls. Indeed, he will be made to stand, for God is able to make him stand.

We Don't Judge People because they are His

exception: authority (Jn 7:24, Pr 18:13, 17 - requires proximity)

Warning: we establish our own standard (vs 2) - mercy, gentleness (Gal 6:1 restorative)

(1Co 11:31-32) <sup>31</sup>For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. <sup>32</sup>But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world.

Only purpose of pre-final judgement is Redemptive (vs 3-5 brother - relational)

Prerequisite: self examination (heart)

Heart Posture: Hunger for Righteousness, Humility, Service, Gentleness, Mercy Warning: unauthorized eye poking (vs 6)

(1Co 4:3-5) <sup>3</sup>But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by a human court. In fact, <u>I do not even judge myself</u>. <sup>4</sup>For <u>I know of nothing against myself</u>, yet <u>I am not justified</u> by this; but <u>He who judges me is the Lord</u>. <sup>5</sup>Therefore <u>judge nothing before the time</u>, until the <u>Lord comes</u>, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and <u>reveal the counsels of the **hearts**</u>. Then each one's praise will come from God.

all of our judgements, even of ourselves, are flawed

2. **Pray** (Mt 7:7-12) - Specifically, Intimately, Persistently (Lk 18:1-8) Golden Rule (vs 12) - context of <u>People</u> (not stuff - Mt 6:25, 33) Pray for Power (Lk 11:13) to Live the SotM with deeply flawed People

3. Fear God (Mt 7:13-14) - vs Fear of Man (crowd)

 $difficult = \underline{afflicted} - 8^{th} Value (2 Tim 3:12)$ 

Warning: don't compromise His narrow SotM ways for the sake of peace

Stuart: People are often more Offended at His Mercy than His Judgements
