Digging Deeper

1. We are called to be a naturally supernatural people. Discuss the following statement: "God wants us to take our eyes off the ordinary and focus on His extraordinary life alive in us." Too often we use our ordinariness as an excuse not to recognize the extraordinary that is alive in us. (Jn 4.13-14, 1 Cor 2.1-5)

2. Read and discuss Matthew 5.13-14. What does it mean to be salt and light in the world? Do we understand who we are in Christ? Discuss the following statement: "Sometimes we forget who we are, we are badder than we think. We are not looking for a cave to live in, we are looking for a platform to stand on. Paul is gone, Peter is gone ... who is God going to use today- He is going to use us. God is looking for people in the church to step up" (P Clyde Oliver). How does this apply to us and how do we walk it out in our lives? (Mat 5.3-11)

3. We are an eternal people who possess eternal life and are destined to live in heavenly places with God. Eternity is the foundation of all our reasoning and thinking. We are a people of faith who operate in the unseen realm to change the seen realm. How does the reality of heaven help us prioritize our lives and our mission and our message while here on earth? (Act 4.29-31, Isa 62.6-7)
